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From the triangle to the spotlight Dressage and show jumping stallion licensing of the Hanoverian Society

Verden. When the gates of the Niedersachsenhalle open at the end of November, there will be excitement in the air: The stallion licensing and stallion sales of the Hanoverian Society are coming up and are the highlight of the breeding year. From 20 to 22 November, the young dressage stallions will show off their great talents. A week later, from 27 to 29 November, the stage will belong to the show jumping stallions. Numerous careers in breeding and sport have already begun here. Both events will be broadcast live on the internet.

A total of 83 two-and-a-half-year-old dressage stallions will be presented to the licensing commission. The collection is characterised by modern, sport-oriented pedigrees and proven, valuable dam lines. After the presentation on the triangle track on Friday, the free presentation will follow on Saturday, before the licensing and award ceremony takes place. The third edition of the FRH Cup for seven- to nine-year-old dressage horses further enriches the programme and shows how closely breeding and sport are related in Verden. This will be followed by a varied show programme with the honouring of the Hanoverian Stallion and Hanoverian Mare of the Year. The stallion sales will begin in the form of an OnLive auction. Bids can be placed both on site and online.

Five days later, 53 promising show jumping stallions from 38 different sires from performance-tested, purebred mare lines will move into their stalls at the Niedersachsenhalle facility. After the warm-up free jumping and inspection on the hard soil on Friday, the second free jumping on Saturday will decide the licensing and premiums. Another highlight awaits the audience with the Hanoverian Show Jumping

Masters, where four- to eight-year-olds compete for the coveted yellow and white winner's sashes. The stallion sales on Saturday is also the highlight of the event for the show jumping stallions.
