The auction year begins

First Verden Auction on January 25

Verden. For the first time this year, customers have the opportunity to purchase a quality riding horse at an auction in Verden. Today the 77 auction horses move into their boxes in the training and sales centre of the Hannoveraner Verband. The auction of the 53 dressage and 24 show jumping horses starts on Saturday, January 25, at 2 pm.

Carefully selected, the collection of the Hannoveraner Verband offers promising young talents for dressage and show jumping. Some of the horses are also a recommendation for eventing as well as for ambitious leisure time riders. The training of the auction horses under the direction of German national trainer Hans-Heinrich Meyer zu Strohen is open to the public daily. After consultation with one of the customer advisors of the Hannoveraner Verband, the horses can be tried out afterwards. The first official presentation will take place on Saturday, January 18. At 10 am the presentation will begin with the show jumping horses. The presentation of the dressage and leisure time horses follows at 1 pm. The presentations on Wednesday, January 22, and the final presentation on Saturday, January 25, will be broadcast live on the website of the Hannoveraner Verband. The presentation of the free jumping on Friday, January 24, at 10 am can also be followed live on the Internet.
