Great international interest

2nd Verden Foal Auction Online achieves average price of 9,875 Euros

Verden. At the second online auction of the Verden Foal Spring, the 26 foals were sold at an average price of 9,875 Euros. The highest price was achieved by the Sezuan daughter Sahara, for whom the bid up ended at 36,500 Euros. About half of the foals found international buyers.

The filly Sahara by Sezuan/Sandro Hit (breeder and exhibitor: Willem Klausing GbR, Diepholz) was the top-priced foal at 36,500 Euros. The most expensive colt was the Bon Courage/Rotspon son Bon Ludwig (breeder: Hans-Ludwig Dittmer, exhibitor: Zuchtgemeinschaft Dittmer, Rhade), for whom a renowned stallion station from Brandenburg paid 16,500 Euros. The jumping foals were also well represented in terms of quantity and price. Dubai by Dallas VDL/Lordanos (breeder and exhibitor: Axel Baumgartner, Kamern) left Germany for the U.S.A. for 13,500 Euros.

14 foals found new owners in Germany. The international interest ranged from Europe to Chile and the USA. Two foals each travel to Belgium, France and Great Britain.

The Verden Foal Spring continues at two-week intervals. The next online foal auction dates with about 20 foals each are: 17 to 20 May, 31 May to 3 June and 14 to 17 June.
