Verden Auction in November

Verden. The last Verden auction of the year will be held on November 12. 112 talented young riding horses, aged three to six, will be put up for auction on Saturday as of 3.00 pm.

73 dressage prospects and 39 show jumping horses will arrive in Verden on Monday, October 31, after the stallion licensing. The collection is adapted to specific customer requirements and provides a wide range of different horses from dressage, show jumping, eventing and pleasure riding. The four-year-old Friedrich Schaper by Foundation/Sandro Hit, bred by Joachim Voigt from Winsen, will be the number one of the auction. He will be exhibited by Dr. Friederike Oppermann-Schmid, Hambühren and already confirmed his dressage potential with one placement achieved in a riding horse development class. Besides, he convinces with first-class basic gaits, super rideability and supple, elastic movements.

Sarentina KJ by Spartacus/Contendro will be the number one of the show jumping collection. The Hanoverian state premium candidate was bred and is owned by Klaus Jürgens from Sehnde. The number three of the auction collection already won and was placed in novice level jumper riding horse classes. Sarentina KJ is half sister of the Celle state stud stallion Diacontinus. She and 19 more auction candidates are registered with the Hanoverian Jumper Breeding Program.

Following a short settling-in period from October 31 to November 4, the first public presentation will follow on Saturday, November 5. The jumpers will be presented as of 10:00 am to be followed by the dressage horses as of 02:00 pm. The auction will start on Saturday, November 12 as of 03:00 pm, marking the finish of the 13 days lasting auction period.
