

## About to start to a successful future

### Hannoveraner Jumping Championships for young horses

**Verden. Hannover's young show jumping talents showed their best side in Verden. The new Hannoveraner show jumping champions are Valensky, Starrico and Karajan.**

The first champions were crowned at the newly built show grounds on the Lindhooper Straße. Two champions are owned by the State Stud Celle. The decision was exciting in the four-year old-class. In the final the best of the qualification started at the end. The Celle State Stud stallion Valensky by Valentino/Cornet Obolensky (breeder: Hendrik A. Könemann, Thomasburg) with rider Sven Rudolph was the one who coped best with the hot weather conditions. A tenth of a second separated him from the winner of the qualifier, Otto de la Roche by Orlando/Check In (breeder: Elke and Claudia Tegtmeyer, Norderney), whom Oliver Ross presented in a masterly manner and who became Vice Champion. Third place went to the son of Diacontinus/Quebec, Dracarys (breeder: Carsten Frerichs, Weener), with Oliver Cordes in the saddle.

There was also a starter in the final of the five-year olds, who did not quite make it to the top in the qualifier: Tobias Meyer presented his Starrico by Stolzenberg/Carrico (breeder: Tanja Reupke, Eicklingen) in the final to the point and took the yellow-white sash. Although gelding, the powerful jumping chestnut is also owned by the Celle State Stud as a training horse. Second place went to the winner of the qualifier, the privately owned sire Valencio by Van Gogh/Vulkano (breeder: Norbert Bramlage, Dinklage) with rider Patrick Döllner. Bronze won Campino MR (Rhld.) by Colestus/Clinton (breeder: Marius Rittstieg, Seeburg) with rider Roman Duchac. The athletic bay is no stranger to

Verden, he was Champion of five-year olds last year and won the free jumping competition of the Hannoveraner Jumper Breeding Program two years ago.

There was a favourite victory among the six-year olds. The Stakkato-Prize winner Karajan by Kannan/Verdi (breeder: Werner Schultze, Heese) not only won the qualifier with Christian Temme, but was also unbeatable in the final on this day. The silver medal went to the son of Stakkato/Cristo, Stuntman (breeder: Siegfried Buhl, Syke) and rider Marvin Drenkhahn. Another son of Stakkato completed the podium. Holger Prekel directed Sterling AG by Stakkato/Calypso II (breeder: Dr. Alexandra Görgens, Steinfeld) to third place.
